The Indiana Municipal Power Agency (IMPA) is the wholesale electric supplier to 44 cities and towns across Indiana. IMPA was formed by state statute in 1980 to bring economies of scale in power supply and transmission service to municipally owned electric utilities around Indiana. IMPA is dedicated to providing economical, reliable and environmentally responsible power to its member communities through a portfolio of IMPA and member-owned generating stations and purchased power resources and through its co-ownership in the state's Joint Transmission System.

Construction Directions!



- Directions to the Indiana Municipal Power Agency:**
- **From US 31/Meridian St.** Go to stoplight at 116th St. Turn east. Go to stoplight at Pennsylvania St. Turn left. Turn right on Congressional Blvd. (first road on right). Turn right again onto 117th Street. Turn right on Technology Drive. IMPA is the last building on the left.
 - **From I-465**— Exit US Hwy 31/Meridian St.(Exit 31) turn north. Turn east (right) on 116th Street. Go to first stoplight at Pennsylvania St. Turn left. Turn right on Congressional Blvd. (first road on right). Turn right again onto 117th Street. Turn right on Technology Drive. IMPA is the last building on the left.
 - **From I-69**—Go to I-465 east and follow directions above. Do not use the 116th Street exit off of I-69. 116th Street is closed before College Avenue.
